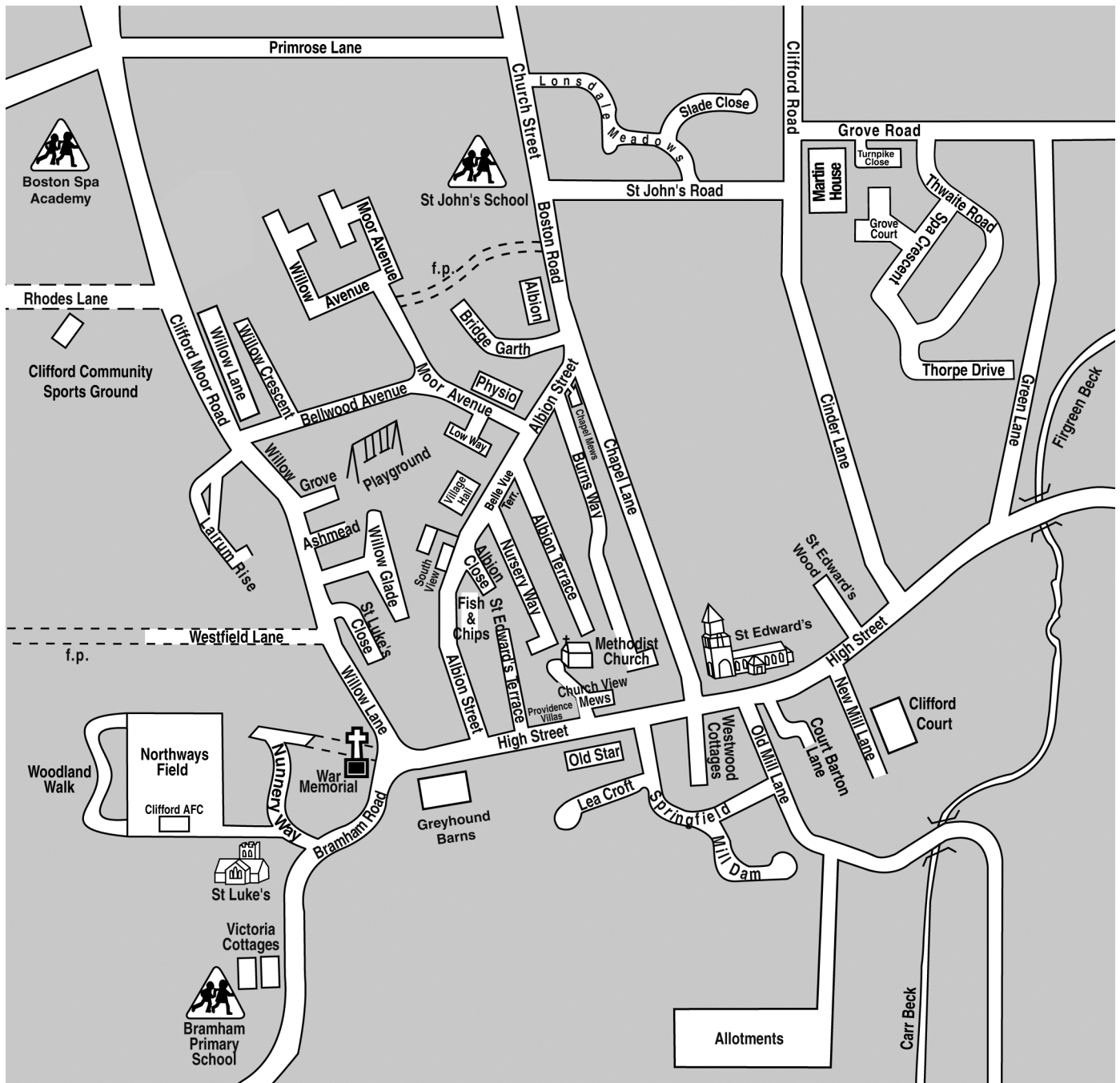

## Clifford and Bramham Road Safety Meetings

On the 10<sup>th</sup> September Leeds City Council Highways held the first of a series of meetings to focus on road safety issues in Clifford and Bramham on 10<sup>th</sup> September. Clifford and Bramham Parish Councillors, Wetherby Ward Councillors, a Senior LCC Highways Engineer and residents from both parishes were in attendance. The aim of the meetings is to identify the priority road safety issues in the two parishes to enable LCC Highways to focus on them and report on progress at the next meeting. LCC Highways acknowledged that there has been considerable slippage with several highways' projects. These meetings should ensure that there is more accountability from Highways and provide an opportunity for Parish Councillors and residents to outline their road safety concerns.

The priority highways projects for the next quarter were identified as:

- Installation of a new pedestrian access at the rear of Bramham Primary School
- A safety review of the Bowcliffe Road/Paradise Way junction
- Review of the speed limit on Aberford Road.

Data from the Speed Indication Devices (SIDs) recently installed in both parishes will be sent to LCC Highways to help identify areas where there is excessive speeding. If indicated, the Ward Councillors will fund police speed enforcement action. In addition to the static SIDs the council has a mobile SID. Please contact the clerk if you have any suggestions for where the mobile SID should be used.

The next meeting will take place at 4 pm on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2024 at the Bramham Parish Centre, Front Street, Bramham, LS23 6JT. Residents are welcome to attend. Alternatively, please let the clerk know if there are any issues you would like to raise with LCC Highways.

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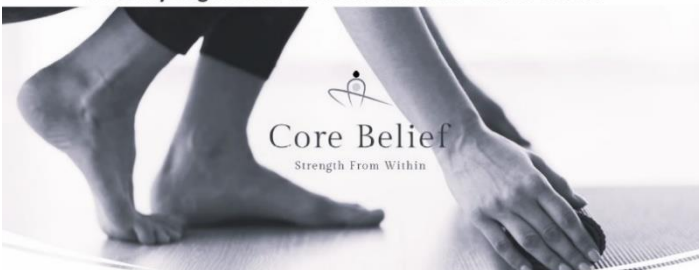



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## **SEASON'S GREETINGS IN OUTLOOK DECEMBER 2024**

## Gardeners Corner – October

The nights are drawing in and it's getting cooler, but we get to see rosier sunlight over the garden, and this shows off the intense colours of the leaves and autumn flowers.

And there is plenty to keep us busy!

### What to do this month

- Rake up leaves particularly off the lawn and paths. As long as there hasn't been a black spot/fungal problem on leaves of roses or shrubs, you can leave leaves on beds.
- Clear weeds and apply mulch.
- Lift leaves and debris off ponds
- Plant evergreens and shrubs.
- Trim conifer hedges
- Plant new climbers, perennials, lily/tulip bulbs.
- Divide larger clumps of perennials such as Lady's mantle (Alchemilla), asters, pulmonaria, geraniums.
- Lift and divide rhubarb, planting it into an area with plenty of well-rotted manure or compost.
- Put up insulation in your greenhouse- suspended bamboo poles and re-using bubble wrap is one great idea.

### Long term planning

- Sow sweet peas under cover- greenhouse or windowsill.
- Prepare the ground for bare root plants if you are buying them. Bare root plants are often available to buy at this time of year and it can save a lot of money, especially on expensive things like roses.

### Mindful moment

Look around for the myriad of colours, tastes, sounds and smells of autumn. Focus on them all and soak up the feelings that come with them right now. Avoid looking back or thinking ahead- this is a beautiful time of year!

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## Heritage Open Days Clifford 9<sup>th</sup> September 2024

Clifford was invited to take part in the Heritage Open Days event, which is sponsored by the National Trust together with, in our area, Leeds Civic Trust. The theme in 2024 is 'Connections' and with this in mind, the three churches in Clifford came together with the Local History Group to organise a 'Great day Out in Clifford'.

The first visitor at 10am to St Luke's had come from Saltaire! He and succeeding visitors were given a tour of the church and viewed a display of pottery, hand-made jewellery, paintings, illuminated letter designs and punch needle art produced by parishioners. There was a steady flow of people through the day who were also entertained by Joyce Martin and Tamsin Holding with an organ recital by St Luke's organist, David Martin. The climax was a recital by Rev Nick Morgan who sang and played the cello.

Clifford Methodist Church was already decorated from the Harvest Festival the previous day and music played in the background. In the schoolroom, refreshments were served (and the toilets were available!) and there was a rolling presentation of photographs shown by the Local History Group. A booklet has been produced about the history of the chapel and schoolroom and is available for a small donation.

St Edward's church also enjoyed a great number of visitors who were treated to organ recitals, illuminating talks about the stained-glass windows and the chronology of St Edward's from its origins over 175 years ago. A highlight was a concert given by the Year 6 choir from St Anne's and Holy Rosary School in Chapeltown, Leeds, who sang joyful renditions of hymns and songs to an appreciative audience.

During the day, Clifford Local History Group escorted two groups on a walk around the village pointing out buildings etc. of historic interest.

The whole day was a great success with visitors telling us how much they had enjoyed their visit. Many, many thanks to everyone who contributed, in whatever way, to a very enjoyable and event!

## Clifford Walking Group - 15<sup>th</sup> August- Hovingham

Our August walk started from the picturesque village of Hovingham sited on the edge of the Howardian Hills after a pleasant drive past the Castle Howard Estate.

The village has a long history with evidence of Roman occupation discovered when construction of the gardens of Hovingham Hall took place. It is also named in the Domesday Book. However, most of the buildings in the village were built in the Georgian period. Thomas Worsley who designed and had built the present Hovingham Hall was a close friend of George III and reputedly taught him to ride. The Hall and surrounding Estate has been owned by the Worsley family since 1563. Probably the most famous member of the family is Katharine Worsley who married the Duke of Kent at York Minster in 1961. The Estate has the largest privately owned cricket pitch in the UK and many legendary cricketers including Herbert Sutcliffe, Len Hutton, Fred Trueman, and Geoff Boycott have all played there.

Seventeen walkers, our best turn out in ages, assembled at the Village Hall car park and we set off on time on a fairly damp morning. We left the village walking alongside the beck heading towards the cemetery then headed off along field-side paths and tracks, an old disused railway line, woodland, and quiet country lanes.

By the time we reached Cawton the rain had stopped, and we decided that it was a suitable spot to eat our lunch.

Post lunch the walk took us along the Ebor Way back towards Hovingham Hall. After about a mile or so the group split into two with half heading straight back for wander around the village and tea and cakes. The other half added an extra loop around the Estate which proved to be a bit longer than anticipated as a couple of footpaths we intended to use had been locked off. However, we were rewarded with excellent views of the Howardian Hills.
